

## **Gilles Piché Memorial Fund**

### **Objective**

To assist CORE Association workers obtain a Certificate or Diploma in Disability and Community Rehabilitation for the purpose of retaining these graduates as employees.

### **Scholarship Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant has received her/his Certificate and/or Diploma in Disability and Community Rehabilitation within the past year and must apply by December 31 of the year that the one-year working period at CORE is completed.

The applicant is a CORE Association employee currently registered in one of the programs at a college or university (i.e. Medicine Hat College, Lethbridge College, Mount Royal College), or through a distributed learning program while working at CORE Association. The funding can be applied for in that year and received while attaining the certificate or diploma. The applicant commits to work for CORE Association for at least one year after receiving the certificate or diploma.

The applicant can apply only once for each certificate or diploma earned.

The funding available is for reimbursement of tuition and books only.
